TEXT PURCHASE OPTIONS

What should you buy and where? Either the SBCC bookstore or online at the publishers site are the two main locations for purchasing course materials. The bookstore does mark up the price by about 22% so the publisher site might offer the better deal. You will have to check on the price differences. Regardless of how and where you purchase the required materials, this course <u>requires that you purchase</u> an access code for the <u>Hawkes Learning Math software</u> and that same access code will give you access to an Etext. You cannot purchase just a text for this course.

Bookstore Option 1: Buy the bundle in the SBCC bookstore. It contains the 3rd edition *Beginning Statistics* Text by Warren, Denley & Atchley and the Hawkes access code to the online software. The online software also includes the Etext. YOU HAVE ALL THAT YOU NEED!

• The Hawkes access code is required for taking quizzes and working online homework (called certifies in Hawkes). The code will also give access to the Etext..

Publisher Site Option 2: Buy either the text and the access code or buy just the access code which also contains the Etext. It's your choice. Personally, I like to have a hard copy of the text but it's your choice.

- If you prefer just the access code which contains the Etext, go to http://www.hawkeslearning.com/. You will not have a hard copy text with this option.

Option 3: Other purchasing options might exist. I don't know what they are or where to go to buy them. If option 1 and 2 above don't work for you, option 3 is for you to explore on your own. You might choose to buy the Hawkes code online through Hawkes, find a cheap used text though Amazon or some other retailer. Options do exist for those on a mission to make it work and/or save money!

Regardless of the option chosen above, you will also need a TI 84 calculator. Other versions might work but the TI 84 is the best for this class. I might not be much help with other versions since I'm not very familiar with them.

Keep one thing in mind, the Hawkes Access Code <u>CANNOT BE SHARED</u> between two or more students. You must have your own.
